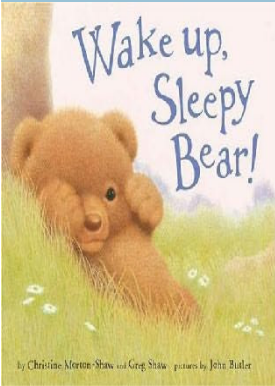


Beyond the Book...

Summary: This fantastic book invites children to the wonderful world of the forest. It allows children to see how many different animals live in the forest as well as how they wake up in the morning.



Before Reading...

Talk with your child about the cover of the book. Take a “picture walk” through the book and talk about the pictures before reading the book.

During Reading...

Stop frequently as you read the words to make the connection to the illustrations. Point out what is happening in the pictures that connects to the words you have read.

After Reading...

Re-read this book to your child. Sing the words; vary the tone of your voice so that it is loud in some places or soft in others; enjoy the poetry of these words!
